FEDERAL AGENCIES CREATE ECONOMIC RECOVERY WEBSITES

Several federal agencies have created webpages to provide information about how they plan to allocate funding received under the Economic Recovery Act, and then to allow monitoring of their actual spending. AAU will soon post on its website a listing of sites for the agencies the association tracks. Below is an initial list.

It is worth noting that the National Institutes of Health has multiple webpages, with more expected. Although AAU does not generally track the National Institute of Standards and Technology, the agency is listed here because it received significant funding in the Recovery Act for university-related activities.
